We design, build, install and service the machines that turn rock into the aggregate that roads, bridges, airports and cities are made of. One company, the whole plant — from the first drawing to the last spare part.

ONE COMPANY. THE WHOLE PLANT.

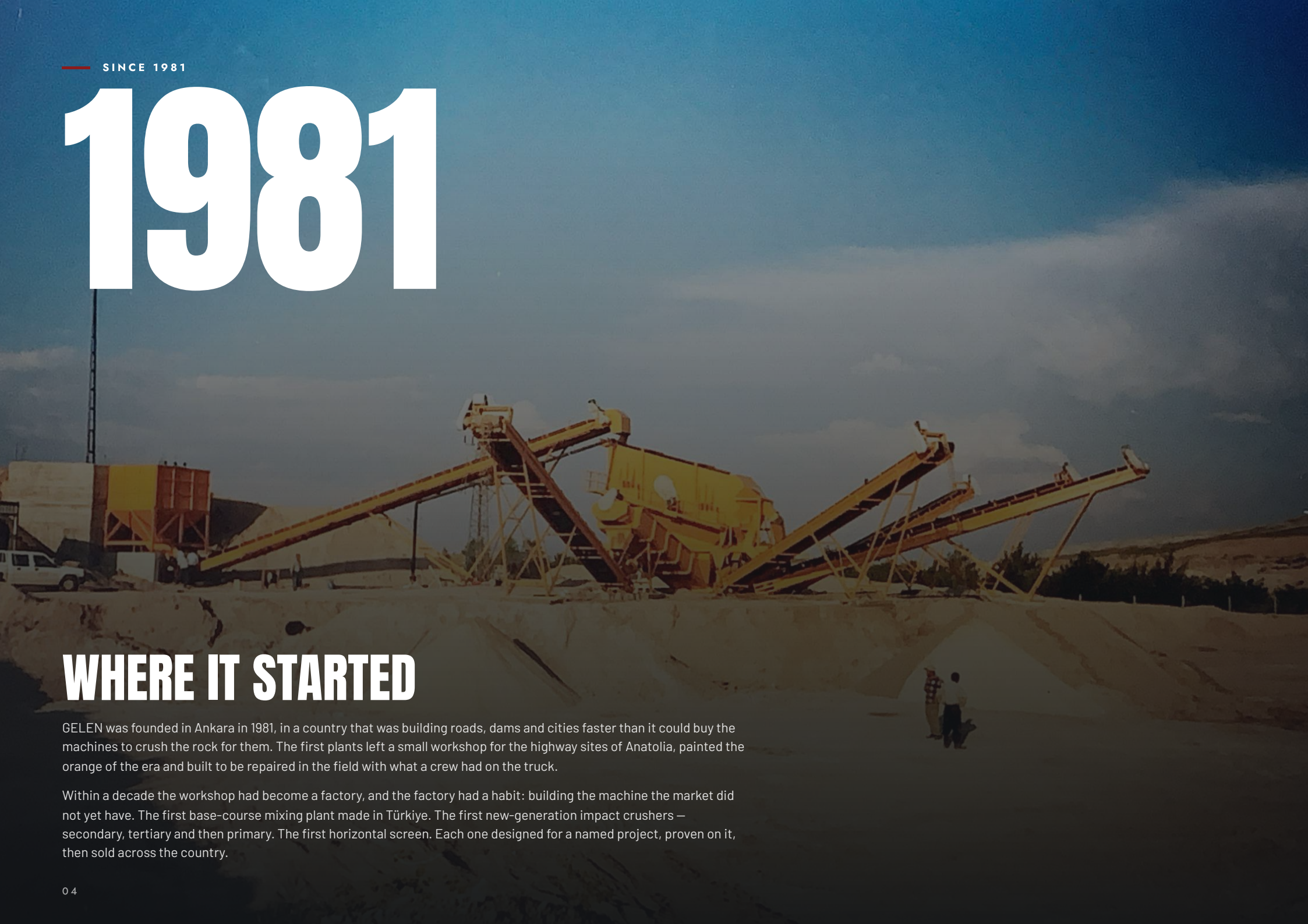
GELEN designs, manufactures, installs and services crushing, screening, washing and material-handling equipment for the aggregate, mining and recycling industries. The company was founded in Ankara in 1981 and has built every machine it sells at its own works in the ASO 1. Organised Industrial Zone since 1997.

Engineering, fabrication, heat treatment, machining, assembly, electrical wiring and commissioning are all done in-house. That is what lets us hold the same tolerances on a 40-tonne jaw crusher as on a screen exciter, and answer a site problem with a redesigned part rather than a generic one.

From a single machine to a complete 1,000 t/h plant, the promise is the same: it runs, it keeps running, and when it needs a part, the part is there.

WHERE IT STARTED

GELEN was founded in Ankara in 1981, in a country that was building roads, dams and cities faster than it could buy the machines to crush the rock for them. The first plants left a small workshop for the highway sites of Anatolia, painted the orange of the era and built to be repaired in the field with what a crew had on the truck.

Within a decade the workshop had become a factory, and the factory had a habit: building the machine the market did not yet have. The first base-course mixing plant made in Türkiye. The first new-generation impact crushers — secondary, tertiary and then primary. The first horizontal screen. Each one designed for a named project, proven on it, then sold across the country.

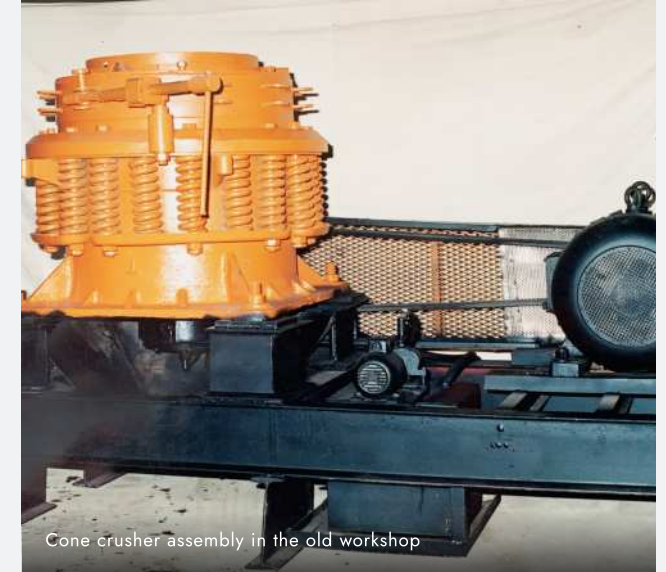

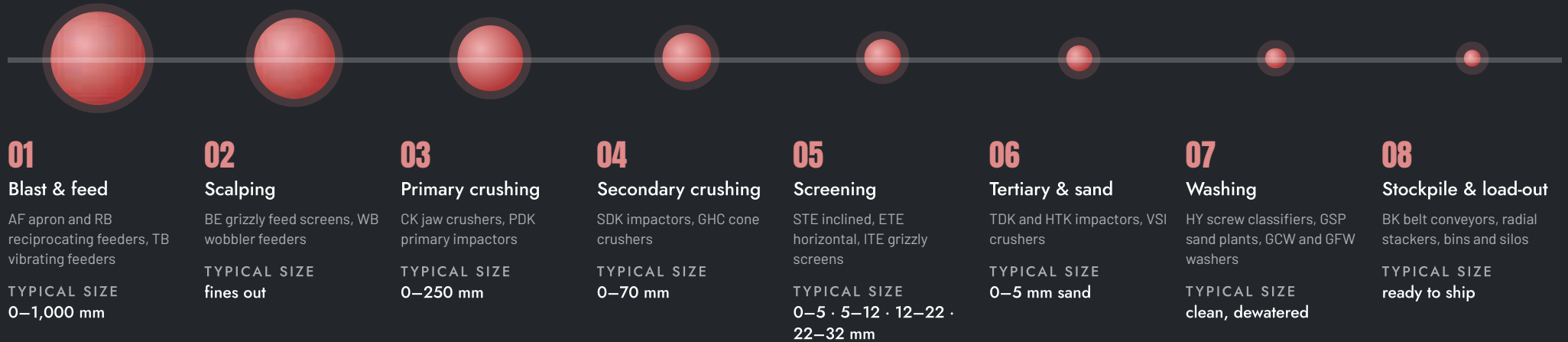

THE JOURNEY OF A ROCK.

Every GELEN machine has a place on this line. A small quarry uses five of the eight stations; an 800 t/h aggregate plant uses all of them, some of them twice.

Jaw crushers

CK series primary and secondary jaw crushers, 340 to 1,200 mm feed.



Impact crushers

PDK primary, SDK secondary, TDK tertiary and HTK high-speed rotors.



VSI crushers

Rock-on-rock vertical shaft impactors for cubical sand.



Cone crushers

GHC hydraulic cone crushers for hard, abrasive rock.



Vibrating screens

Inclined, grizzly, elliptical horizontal and fine-sand screens.



Feeders

Vibrating, grizzly, wobbler, reciprocating and apron feeders.



Washing & classification

Screw classifiers, sand plants, log washers, blade mills, hydrosand.



Continuous mixers

MP series twin-shaft mixing plants for base course and stabilised soil.



Material handling

Belt conveyors, radial stackers, bins and silos.



Mobile units

Wheeled crushing and screening plants on road-legal chassis.



Automation

Plant control, remote monitoring and production reporting.

A GELEN plant is designed as one machine. Feed, crushing stages, screening, washing, conveying and control are sized together from the feed material and the product spec — then built, installed and commissioned by the same people.

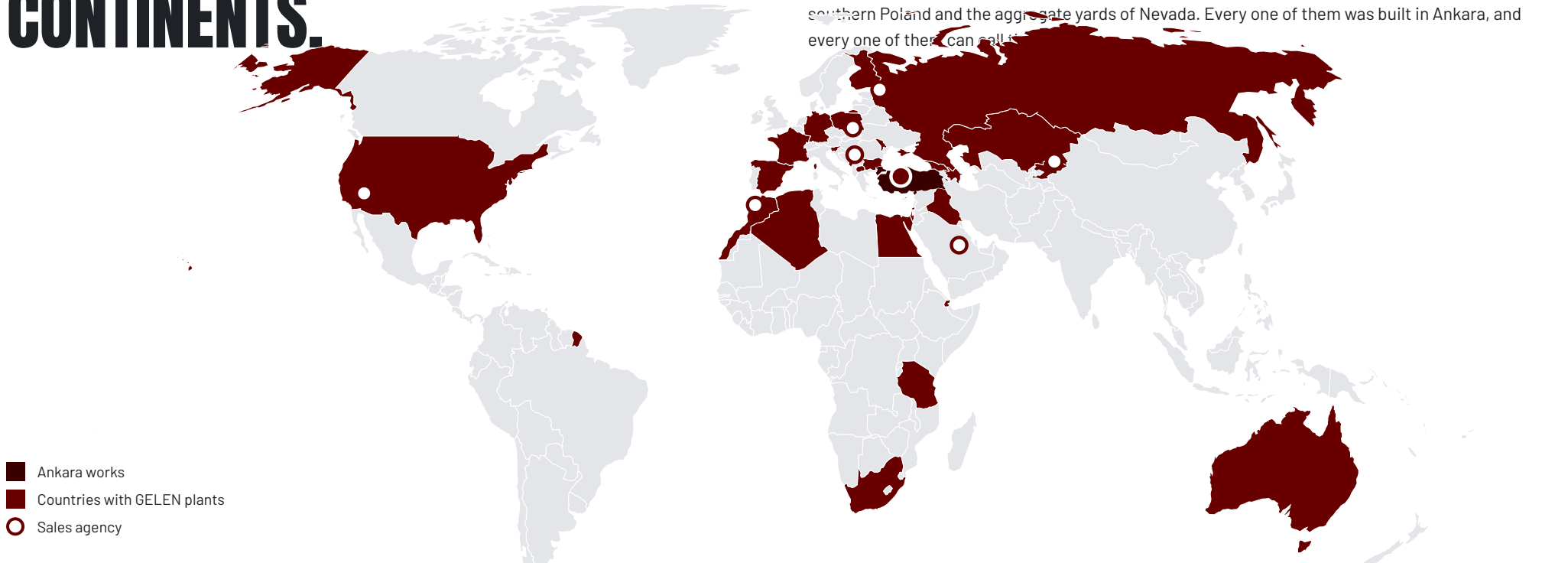

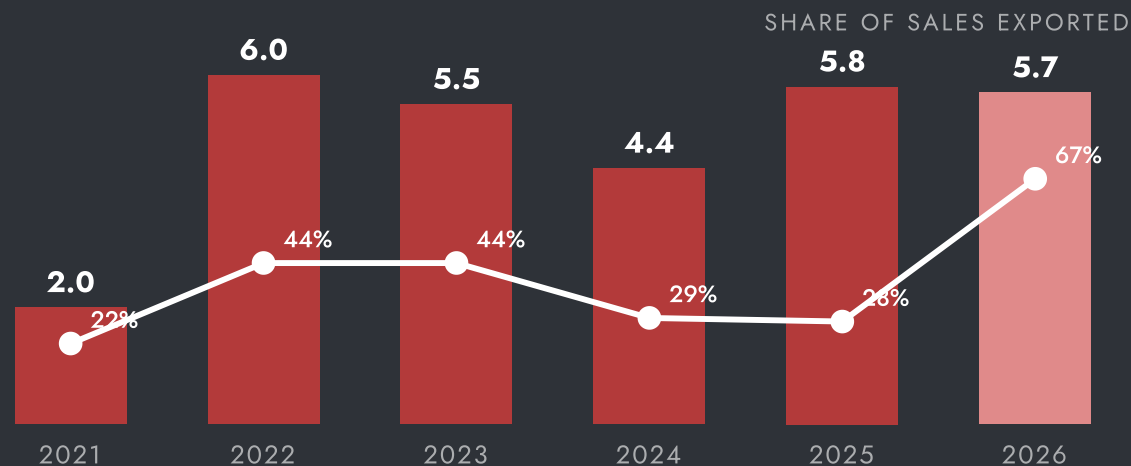

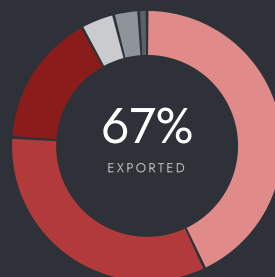
From a fifth of the business to two thirds of it.

A dealer network from Poland to Nevada, and a product line built for the toughest feed, took exports from a fifth of sales in 2021 to two thirds of them in 2026. Plant orders are lumpy by nature – one 450 t/h plant is a year of spares – so the line matters more than any single bar.

THREE HOURS FROM ANYWHERE THAT BUILDS.

Ankara sits between Europe, the Gulf, Central Asia and Africa, in the country that has become the region's machinery works. A GELEN engineer is on a site in Warsaw or Riyadh the same day, and a machine is on a truck to Poland or a ship at Mersin within a week of leaving the paint line.

EVERYTHING UNDER ONE ROOF.

Steel comes in as plate and leaves as a crusher. Every process that decides whether a machine lasts — cutting, welding, stress relief, machining, assembly, wiring, testing — happens on one site in Ankara.

Every machine leaves after a documented mechanical run-in, a no-load test at operating speed and a final inspection filed against its serial number.

DESIGNED WITH DATA. PROVEN ON SITE.

R&D at GELEN is not a department; it is how every product is made — designed in 3D, checked with structural and flow simulation, prototyped in the works and optimised against data from running plants.

Efficiency

Higher capacity per kilowatt, from chamber geometry to drive selection.

Wear parts and frames designed for the hardest feed, not the average one.

Automation

Smart controls that keep a plant at its set point without an operator watching it.

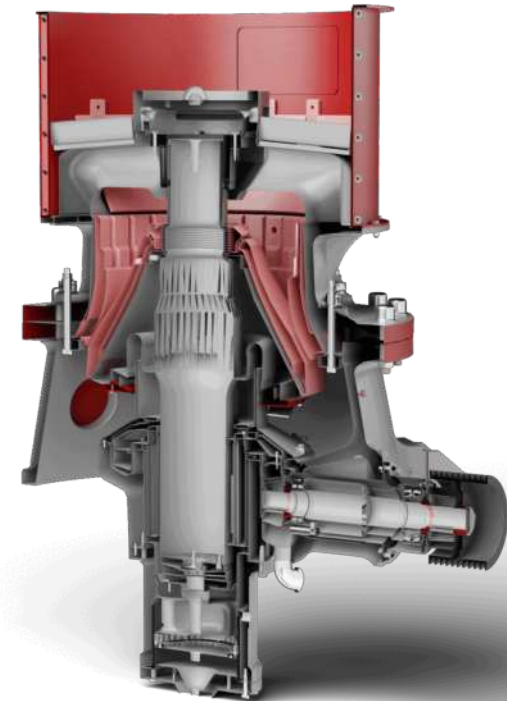

EVERY MACHINE HAS A SERIAL. EVERY SERIAL HAS A QR.

Since 2025 each GELEN machine leaves the works with a serial number and a QR code on its nameplate. Scan it and the machine's own page opens: its parts list, its manuals, its service history — and a spares order in one tap.

CHEAPER PER TONNE. NOT JUST PER MACHINE.

The price of a crusher is a small part of what it costs to run for five years. Energy, wear parts, downtime and spares are the rest — and every one of them is a design decision taken at the works.

01

Energy per tonne

Chamber geometry and drive sizing matched to the feed, not oversized for the brochure.

02

Wear-part life

Jaw plates and blow bars in GELEN's own alloys, cast for the material on site.

03

Plant availability

Access doors, hydraulic setting and stocked spares keep stops short.

04

Spare-part price

Parts from the works, priced from the works — no importer in between.

What a plant costs to run is decided long before the invoice — in the chamber, the alloy, the access door and the parts shelf.
